Mr. Reardon joined Appleton and PDC as a director in June 2007. Mr. Reardon retired in November 2008 as the chairman and chief executive officer of TTX Company, positions he held since June 1, 2008. Prior to June 1, 2008, he was the president and chief Executive officer of TTX Company, positions he held since 2001. He currently consults with TTX and is a principal in the law firm of Reardon & Chasar, L.P.A., located in Cincinnati, engaged in business and transportation law and representation before legislative bodies. He joined TTX in 1992 as vice president of human resources and labor relations. He later served as vice president of law and human resources and was named president of the company in 2000. TTX is the largest supplier of leased railcars in North America. Mr. Reardon earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Notre Dame (English) in 1967 and a juris doctor degree from the University of Cincinnati in 1974. He also earned a L.L.M. degree in taxation from Washington University Law School in 1975. Mr. Reardon's business and legal experience as a principal in a law firm, current consultant and former chief executive officer and vice president of law and human resources for a major North American railcar supply company, as well as his leadership experience in these positions and his graduate degree in law, led to the conclusion that he should serve as a director of Appleton and PDC.
